

General Information & Rules—

- ◆ Reservations are required to assure adequate staffing.
- ◆ Advance reservations may be made by calling x313 after 12pm (noon) or stopping by the Member Services Desk and filling out a Reservation/Cancellation Request Form, up to one week in advance.
- ◆ After hours, daily reservations may be left on our voicemail, x313. If we exceed our ratios, your name will go on a waiting list. You will be notified when there is an opening.
- ◆ There is a two-hour time limit for reservations. A second reservation may be made, provided there is one-half hour between visits. Infants 3-6 months may only have one visit per day.
- ◆ A permanent time may be requested for standing reservations.
- ◆ Cancellation of a reservation must be made at least two hours in advance to avoid a "late cancellation" charge. Failure to cancel will result in a "no show" fee. See Child Care Reservation Desk for fees.
- ◆ For health and sanitation reasons, our team members will not change diapers. Changing tables are located in both bathrooms within the department. You will be paged if your child needs changing. If their clothes are wet or soiled, a change of clothes must be put on before the child returns to Child Care.
- ◆ Bare feet are not allowed (including infants).
- ◆ No child will be permitted in Child Care if any of the following conditions exist: runny nose, deep cough, diarrhea, rash, elevated temperature, red eyes or eye discharge. Your child must be free of these symptoms for 24 hours before returning.
- ◆ A physician's note may be required for any conditions or allergies that are being treated and declared harmless.
- ◆ Only parents or legal guardians are allowed to drop off or pick up their children.
- ◆ Our team members will do our best to work with any child who may have special needs. However, we reserve the right to refuse any child who is unable to adjust to our Child Care services.



Child care is offered for children who are dependents on their parent's memberships. The parent must remain at the Club during the time of the reservation.

Our friendly caregivers will interact and lead age-appropriate activities. For the safety of each child, Wheaton Sport Center team members are First Aid, CPR, and AED certified and follow the recommended guidelines for safe child ratios set by DCFS for each age group.

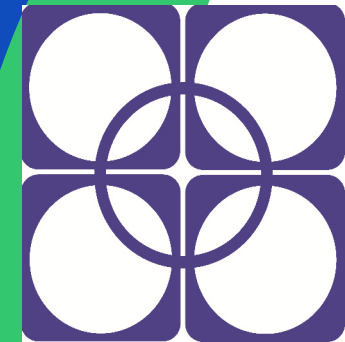


Game Lounge:

The Baby Room

Age 3 months to walking

The Tot Lot

Walking Toddler up to age 2

This area provides a safe environment with age appropriate activities for the growing and curious toddler. At this age, we begin to focus on group activities. We feature circle time with stories, songs and crafts that appeal to this age group.

Our toddlers receive special care in an atmosphere designed for their need to discover and explore their surroundings.



The Main Room

Ages 2-3



This room has a wide selection of toys and playing stations for the children to foster their imagination. With their growing minds, our focus is a teacher-led "Circle Time" featuring weekly themes to explore through stories, music, and dramatic play. This creative environment is sure to enhance your child's overall development.

The Messy Room

Ages 2-3

This area is designed to brighten up any child's day by coloring, painting, crafts, creating with play dough and playing around a sand and water table. Cooperation, sharing, "hands-on" creativity and freedom of expression are encouraged in all art forms.



Gym & Outdoor Playground

Ages 2 and up



Everyone is an "all star" in our sports arena as we work on the development of large motor skills. The gym may be set up for soft form tumble toys and mats, structured games and organized sports including basketball soccer, floor hockey, jump rope, kickball and free play. The outdoor playground includes a jungle gym, four square a sandbox and lots of fresh air. Active play, following directions and good sportsmanship are encouraged in these areas. Gym shoes are required.

Kids' Club Stadium

Ages 4-7

This sports-themed room is geared for a more active age group, where kids can interact with each other while playing age appropriate games and activities. The choices of play in this room include creative play with an art/craft area, and building materials such as Legos, K'Nex, Lincoln Logs, etc. Group activities include a bumper pool table, foosball table and board games. Cooperation, fair play, creativity and higher-level thinking skills are encouraged.



The Upper Deck Game Lounge

Ages 8-13

This exciting game lounge features electronic sports games that will encourage hand-eye coordination, team participation, and active play. In this independent environment, older kids will have the opportunity to socialize, play board games, do homework, read a book, or just relax!



During Your Visit—

Have your WSC membership ID card ready for dropping off and picking up your child at the Child Care Check-in/out Desk. For each child's safety, it is mandatory that you sign in/out your child.

- ◆ Child Care will print a name tag for your child.
- ◆ Please write your location/activity on the name tag. Highlight any special needs or requirements on the tag.
- ◆ Please label all belongings — bags, outerwear, bottles, drinks, snacks, and pacifiers with your child's name. before visiting Child Care.
- ◆ Please collapse any strollers.
- ◆ Healthy snacks are allowed in the Child Care area at designated snack times. Foods such as gum, candy and peanut products, are not allowed because they either can be a choking hazard to small children, or a health hazard to children with allergies.
- ◆ We also allow baby bottles and spill proof containers, such as water bottles, juice boxes and pouches. We also have a drinking fountain in the Department for your child's use.
